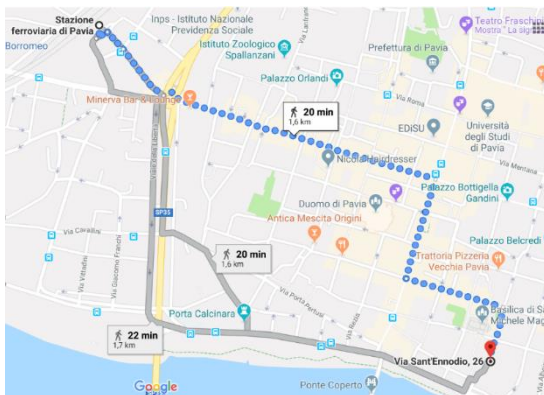
Getting to Palazzo Vistarino

Palazzo Vistarino is located in a limited-traffic area. It is accessible by car from the 'Lungoticino Sforza' (where it is possible to park) and from Berengario square.

It is 20 minutes walking distance from the train station of Pavia and 9 minutes walking distance from the University of Pavia, following these directions:

i) from the train station of Pavia (Piazzale della Stazione, 10) to Palazzo Vistarino (Via Sant'Ennodio, 26):

1. Head southwest toward via Alessandro Guidi/Piazzale della Stazione – 27 m.
2. Sharp left onto via Alessandro Guidi/Piazzale della Stazione – 31 m.
3. Turn right onto via Giovanni Falcone e Paolo Borsellino – 56 m.
4. Continue onto viale Vittorio Emanuele II – 150 m.
5. At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto Corso Camillo Cavour – 700 m.
6. Turn right onto corso Strada Nuova – 250 m.
7. Turn left onto corso Giuseppe Garibaldi – 250 m.
8. Turn right onto via Sant'Ennodio – 140 m.
9. Destination will be on the left.



ii) from Palazzo Vistarino (via Sant'Ennodio, 26) to the University of Pavia (Corso Strada Nuova, 65):

1. Head north on via Sant'Ennodio toward via Severino Capsoni – 140 m.
2. Continue onto via Villa Giori – 85 m.
3. Continue onto via Morazzone – 180 m.
4. Turn left onto corso Giuseppe Mazzini – 8 m.
5. Turn right onto via Defendente Sacchi – 170 m.
6. Turn left onto via Lazzaro Spallanzani – 80 m.
7. Turn right onto via Giuseppe Galliano – 18 m.
8. Turn left – 40 m.
9. Destination will be on the left.
